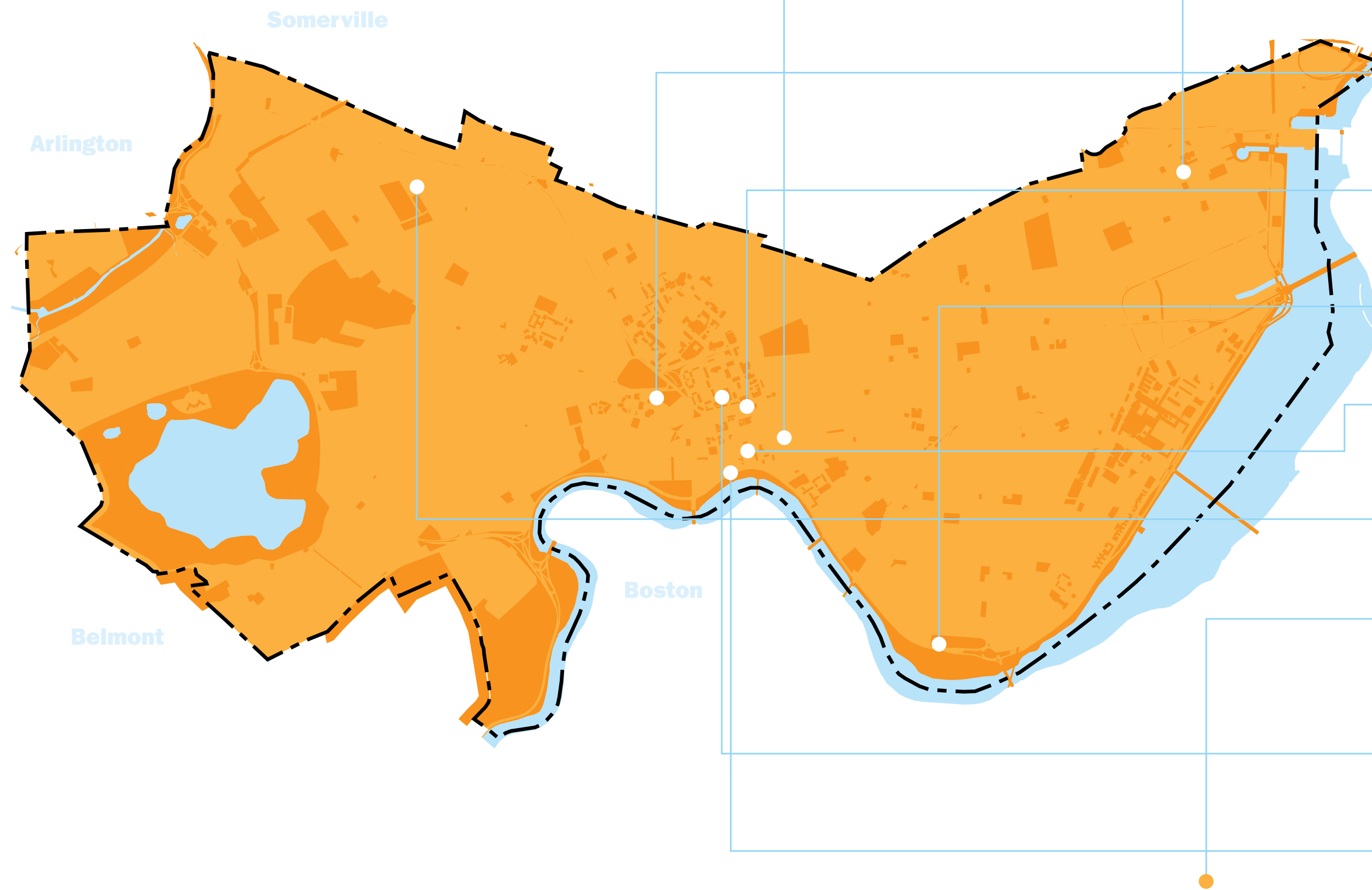

The Cambridge Rindge & Latin School is in the midst of a major renovation. The "Arts building", which houses the CPS Visual and Performing Arts Department, is part of the first phase of this exciting project. When this portion of the renovation is completed in 2010, CRLS will boast a state of the art auditorium and related performance, exhibition and work space to rival the arts home of many small colleges.

Until the renovation is complete, the CRLS performance and exhibition space is closed to students, staff and the public. But the shows, concerts and exhibits must go on and they will!

Thanks to many of our community arts partners, the Cambridge Public Schools Visual and Performing Arts performances and exhibitions are being housed at a number of locales around the city, including local universities, private theaters, assembly halls, churches and other venues. About the Cambridge Public Schools Visual and Performing Arts Department

The Visual and Performing Arts Department of the Cambridge Public Schools offers music and visual arts grades K-12, as well as drama and dance grades 9-12.

The Cambridge Rindge & Latin School program includes eight visual arts teachers and eight performing arts teachers. Included in our offerings are ceramics, photography, drawing, painting, digital art, fashion design, sculpture, acting, directing, film study, modern dance, orchestra, band, percussion, piano studies, and chorus.

For this reason, as well as its conservatory-like arts environment and extraordinary teachers, Cambridge is regularly recognized as one of the best high schools in the state - public or private - for the arts.

CRLS's award-winning drama program offers classes and opportunities for students to perform on stage as well as work behind the scenes. CRLS is a perennial finalist in the Massachusetts High School Drama Festival.

CRLS photography classes are regularly recognized state-wide as being among the highest quality in the Globe Scholastic Art Awards. Dance classes are taught throughout the day, and the CRLS Dance Company regularly draws 60-70 students after school several times per week to dance. The percussion program includes the CRLS Drumline, which marches in parades, at football games and other special occasions. CRLS also features three jazz ensembles: Beginning, Advanced, and the World Jazz Ensemble.
